

PLEASE CUT ALONG LINES

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Reddish brown, grey to white below.
-

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Brownish in colour.
 - Its body is divided into segments clearly seen in rings.
-

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Barrel shaped body with large spade-like forelimbs built for digging. Short tail held erect.
 - Plush velvety black fur lies in any direction.
 - Eyes buried by fur and may even be covered by skin. No outer ears.

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Long ears.
 - Black tips on ears.
 - Short tail.
 - Long legs for speed.

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Has pricked ears and white tipped bushy tail, a reddish-brown coat, darker on shoulders and white below.

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Summer coat dark reddish brown, longer and more grey-brown in winter.
 - Powerful build with nervous bearing.
 - Male has compact neck with mane.

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Mainly greyish but with some reddish patches in summer coat.

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Pointed wings and a long slim tail.
 - Male – spotted chestnut back, grey head, rump and tail.
 - Female – more rusty brown with barred upperside.

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- A powerfully built ground dweller on short legs and strong claws for digging.
 - Coarse coat of stiff black and grey hairs. Belly and legs black.
 - Conspicuous black stripe over each eye and ear contrasts with white face.

FEATURES – LOOKS AND COLOURING

- Chubby, chicken-like game bird with rufous upperside, grey neck and underside, pale chestnut head.
 - Both sexes have a conspicuous brown patch on lower breast.
